

Submit YOUR ACCOUNT to VFW Magazine's VIETNAM BOOK PROJECT

VFW magazine will be publishing a book entitled Vietnam's Deadliest Battles for the 50th anniversary of the Vietnam War. It is based on the five-year series in the magazine that ran from October 2003 through March 2009. It included 40 articles, starting with the Marine Battle of Chu Lai in August 1965 and ending with Air Force AC-130 gunship shootdowns over Laos in 1972.

Nine articles that covered actions in the 1970s were published in the magazine between 2010 and 2012 and will be part of the book. These stories were about the following:
